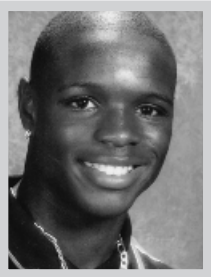

WOMEN IN FOCUS, INC.
THE MISS ANNIE MAE MCCLAIN
SCHOLARSHIP

Through the generosity of Women in Focus member, Carol Lobes and her husband Joe McClain, a special scholarship was established in 2006 honoring the late Annie Mae McClain, Joe's mother. Mrs. McClain left her beautiful collection of designer hats to her son who gifted them to Women In Focus. The hats were exhibited at the Overture Center in Madison and the Milwaukee County Historical Society. Both Joe and Carol felt that Miss Annie Mae would want her beloved hats to contribute to the higher education of young people of color. A subsequent auction of the hats resulted in the establishment of the Miss Annie Mae Scholarship Fund which supported scholarship awards in 2007 and 2008. In May 2008, WIF held a spring fundraising event called "Hats on in the Garden" at Olbrich Gardens where guests enjoyed afternoon tea, musical entertainment and an opportunity to wear hats. The 2008 "Miss Annie Mae McClain" Scholarship recipient is Nathaniel Pharmer-Eden.
