Scholarship Fund

Women In Focus, Inc., a Madison-area women’s service organization, uses funds raised through its annual “I Have a Dream” Ball, the Miss Annie Mae Hat Auction and other events to award scholarships to deserving college-bound male and female students selected by its Scholarship Review Committee. The amount of the scholarships is determined annually, with minimum individual awards of \$2000. There will also be a one-year full tuition award to the University of Wisconsin-Madison.

Application forms are available in the offices of area high school Minority Services Coordinators and online at www.womeninfocus.net

Students selected to receive scholarships must verify full-time enrollment (registration confirmation) at a two-year or four-year college. Recipients are honored at an Award Reception in April; award checks are mailed after recipients provide Women In Focus, Inc. with registration documentation.

Eligibility Criteria

In reviewing applications, preference is given to candidates who are

- Students of Color
- U.S. Citizens or permanent residents
- Graduating Madison-area high school seniors with the exception of Miss Annie Mae McClain scholarship candidates who may be older or continuing students

Application Requirements

Only applications that are completed and postmarked by **February 15, 2008** will be reviewed. There will be no exception. Women In Focus, Inc. Scholarship applications are complete only if the following items are submitted:

- An official high school or college transcript.
- Four copies of the *Applicant Information* sheet (page two) and the *Achievements and Goals* materials (listed on page three)
- A recommendation letter from a high school/college teacher or other staff member.
- A recommendation letter from another non-related adult.
- A photo of the applicant.
- Signed *Publication permission and verification* form (page four)
